3. H.B. 9 Health Care Cost and Quality Data (M. Morley)

- and a specific payer.

Rep. Morley gave further explanation of the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Goodfellow moved to pass the bill out favorably as amended.

4. S.B. 134 Psychologist Licensing Act Amendments (L. Hillyard)
