  - whether the adult adoptee resides, or will reside, with the adoptors \_\_, unless the court, based on a finding of good cause, waives the requirements of Section 78-30-3.5 \_.
- 2. Page 4, Lines 103a through 103f House Committee Amendments 1-25-2007:
  - 103a  $\hat{H} \rightarrow \underline{(6)}$  {After} Except as provided in Subsection (7), after a court enters a final decree of adoption of an adult, the adult
