Senator Margaret Dayton proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Line 18:
 - increase in the value of the weighted pupil unit;
 - ▶ allows the president of an institution of higher education to authorize a partial tuition charge of up to \$25 per credit hour if there is not adequate funding for concurrent enrollment courses at that institution;
- *Page 3, Line 74:*
 - 74 (ii) teaching is done through live classroom instruction or telecommunications; {-and-}
- *Page 3, Line 78:* 3.
 - 78 university campuses; and
 - (iv) students may only be charged fees or partial tuition in accordance with Subsections (6) and (7); and
- *Page 4, Line 97:*
 - 97 (iii) (A) {-Higher-} Except as provided in Subsection (7), education tuition and fees may not be charged for participation in this
- Page 4, Line 103:
 - 103 additional admissions application fee may be charged by the institution.
 - (7) If the president of an institution of higher education determines that there is not adequate funding for the concurrent enrollment courses offered through that institution, the president may authorize the institution to charge partial tuition of up to \$25 per credit hour for each concurrent enrollment course for which the student will receive college credit, paid directly to the institution of higher education that offers the credit.
