Page 3, Lines 76 through 84: 76 (5) The board $\{ \frac{may}{may} \}$: 77 (a) may use up to 15% of the total fund revenues for the actual and necessary operating <u>June</u> 30, 2009; expenses of the board from July 1, 2007 through {April} 78 79 (b) beginning { May } July 1,2009 { -} (i) may use up to 7% of the total fund revenues for the actual and 80 necessary operating expenses of the board; and (ii) shall use not less than 50% of the balance of the fund, calculated as of July 1 of each year, to directly assist individuals who meet the qualifications in Subsection (6) with rehabilitation services during each fiscal year. (c) may seek outside donations from public and private entities to offset operating expenses; 81 82 and 83 (d) may contract with public and private organizations to provide the services in Subsection 84 (4). 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Subsection (5)(b)(ii) .
