Representative **D. Gregg Buxton** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 16 through 22:
  - elderly, or the disabled in health care facilities, or as an EMT, if the applicant:
  - is under the age of  $\{30\}$  28; or
  - is over the age of  $\{30\}$  28 if the individual has a criminal record as an adult;
  - limits the department's current authority to access juvenile records for certain people
  - associated with child care facilities to those people:
  - under the age of  $\{-30\}$  28; or
  - over the age of  $\{30\}$  if the individual has a criminal record as an adult; and
- 2. Page 2, Lines 57 through 58:
  - 57 (a) the applicant is under the age of  $\{\frac{30}{28}\}$  ; or
  - (b) the applicant is over the age of {30} and has been convicted, has pleaded no contest,
- 3. Page 5, Lines 129 through 130:
  - (i) the individual is under the age of (30) years; or
  - (ii) the individual is over the age of {30} and has been convicted, has pleaded no contest,
- 4. Page 8, Lines 219 through 221:
  - 219 (i) the person described in Subsection (1) is under the age of {30} ; or
  - 220 (ii) the person described in Subsection (1) is:
  - $(A) over the age of <math>\{\frac{30}{4}\}$  28; and
