Representative Merlynn T. Newbold proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 11, Lines 328 through 330 House Committee Amendments 2-9-2007:
  - (b) A scho<u>ol representative shall</u> { , upon request, } provide to a parent of a school-age 328
  - 329 minor, a list of resources available to assist the parent in resolving the school-age minor's
  - 330 disruptive student behavior problem.
    - (c) A local school board or governing board of a charter school shall establish procedures for a school counselor or other designated school representative to work with a qualifying minor who engages in disruptive student behavior in order to attempt to resolve the minor's disruptive student behavior problems before the qualifying minor becomes subject to the jurisdiction of the juvenile court as provided for under this section.
- Page 12, Lines 363 through 365:
  - 363 (7) (a) A qualifying minor to whom a habitual disruptive student behavior citation is
  - 364 issued under Subsection (6) shall be referred to the juvenile court for violation of Subsection
  - 365 (3).
    - Within five days after the day on which a habitual disruptive student behavior citation is **(b)** issued, a representative of the school district or charter school shall provide documentation, to a parent of the qualifying minor who receives the citation, of the efforts made by a school counselor or representative under Subsection (4)(c).
