## Senator **Ed Mayne** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 16 through 20:
  - requires the Department of Health to <a href="https://www.withinfunds.appropriated-by-the-Legislature for this-">withinfunds appropriated by the Legislature for this-</a>
    <a href="mailto:purpose">purpose</a>, and subject to approval by the federal government, provide home or community-based services to</a>
  - 17 a Medicaid eligible aged person who is a resident of Utah and who qualifies to be
  - placed in, or remain in, a nursing home, if the person applies to receive the services
  - and the services can be provided at a cost to the state that is equal to, or less than, 50 percent of
  - 20 the cost to the state of maintaining the person in a nursing home;
- 2. Page 2, Line 54:
  - 54 (1) {The} Within funds appropriated by the Legislature for this purpose, and subject to

    approval by the federal government, the department shall provide home or community-based services to an aged person
- 3. Page 3, Lines 63 through 65:
  - (b) the cost to the state of providing the home or community-based services described
  - 64 <u>in this Subsection (1) is less than, or equal to,</u> 50 percent of the cost to the state of providing care to the
  - 65 person in a nursing home.
