Representative **Scott L Wyatt** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 10 through 12:*

10 This bill modifies procedures for exempting minors who are home schooled from  
11 attendance at a public or private school and addresses ~~{-private school and home school-}~~  
12 students' eligibility to participate in extracurricular activities.

2. *Page 1, Line 23:*

23 from which the student withdrew; ~~{-and-}~~

3. *Page 2, Line 26:*

26 with eligibility standards for fully enrolled public school students ~~{-}~~ **; and**  
**▶ addresses public school students' academic eligibility to participate in extracurricular activities.**

**Section 3. Section 53A-11-1201 is enacted to read.**

**53A-11-1201. Extracurricular activities - academic eligibility.**

**(1) A public school student shall meet academic eligibility requirements to participate in extracurricular activities by providing an affidavit from the student's parent or guardian that:**

**(a) the student is mastering the material in each course or subject taken; and**

**(b) the student is maintaining satisfactory progress towards advancement or promotion.**

**(2) A public school student who becomes academically ineligible to participate in an extracurricular activity may not regain eligibility until the student demonstrates academic eligibility by providing test results or a portfolio of the student's work.**
