(a) the student is mastering the material in each course or subject taken; and

(b) the student is maintaining satisfactory progress towards advancement or promotion.

- (2) A public school student who becomes academically ineligible to participate in an extracurricular activity may not regain eligibility until the student demonstrates academic eligibility by providing test
