- 1. Page 5, Lines 138 through 140:
 - (e) (i) Private school students and home school students shall be eligible for
 - extracurricular activities at a public school consistent with eligibility standards

 prohibiting recruiting, as applied to
 - fully enrolled public school students, except as provided in Subsections (7)(f) through (h); and
- 2. Page 5, Line 146 through Page 6, Line 150:
 - 146 (g) To demonstrate a home school student's compliance with scholastic eligibility
 - requirements, the individual providing the primary instruction of a home school student shall
 - 148 <u>submit</u> { <u>an affidavit that indicates:</u>
 - 149 <u>(i) the student is mastering the material in each course or subject being taught; and</u>
 - (ii) the student is maintaining satisfactory progress towards advancement or promotion. }

 the principal of the school where the student seeks to participate, evidence verifying the student's academic performance.
- 3. Page 6, Lines 151 through 155:
 - (h) A public school student who has been declared to be academically ineligible to
 - participate in an extracurricular activity and who subsequently enrolls in a home school shall
 - lose eligibility for participation in the extracurricular activity until the student:
 - (i) demonstrates academic eligibility { by providing test results or a portfolio of the
 - 155 student's work as provided in Subsection (7)(g);
