Representative Curtis Oda proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 12 through 15:
  - This bill:
  - designates { three } \_\_four \_ members of the Senate, appointed by the president of the Senate;
  - designates { five } seven members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker
  - of the House; and
- 2. *Page 1, Lines 23 through 25:* 
  - This bill appropriates:
  - \$8,120 to the Senate; and
  - \$14,210 to the House of Representatives.
- *3. Page 2, Lines 34 through 39:* 
  - 34 (1) There is created the Judicial Retention Election Task Force consisting of the
  - 35 <u>following</u> { <u>11 } 14 members:</u>
  - 36 (a) {three} four members of the Senate appointed by the president of the Senate, no more than
  - 37 {two} three of whom may be from the same political party;
  - 38 (b) { five } seven members of the House of Representatives appointed by the speaker of the
  - 39 House of Representatives, no more than { three } of whom may be from the same political party;
- 4. *Page 3, Lines 69 through 73:* 
  - There is appropriated from the General Fund for fiscal year 2007 only:
  - 70 (1) {\$6,090} to the Senate to pay for the compensation and expenses of senators on the
  - 71 task force; and
  - 72 (2) {\$10,150} to the House of Representatives to pay for the compensation and expenses
  - of representatives on the task force.
