JUDICIAL SELECTION PROCEDURES AND RETENTION ELECTION TASK FORCE

Representative **Curtis Oda** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 12 through 15:*

12 This bill:

13 ▶ designates ~~{three}~~ four members of the Senate, appointed by the president of the Senate;

14 ▶ designates ~~{five}~~ seven members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker

15 of the House; and

2. *Page 1, Lines 23 through 25:*

23 This bill appropriates:

24 ▶ ~~{\$6,090}~~ \$8,120 to the Senate; and

25 ▶ ~~{\$10,150}~~ \$14,210 to the House of Representatives.

3. *Page 2, Lines 34 through 39:*

34 (1) There is created the Judicial Retention Election Task Force consisting of the
35 following ~~{11}~~ 14 members:

36 (a) ~~{three}~~ four members of the Senate appointed by the president of the Senate, no more than
37 ~~{two}~~ three of whom may be from the same political party;

38 (b) ~~{five}~~ seven members of the House of Representatives appointed by the speaker of the
39 House of Representatives, no more than ~~{three}~~ five of whom may be from the same political party;

4. *Page 3, Lines 69 through 73:*

69 There is appropriated from the General Fund for fiscal year 2007 only:

70 (1) ~~{\$6,090}~~ \$8,120 to the Senate to pay for the compensation and expenses of senators on the
71 task force; and

72 (2) ~~{\$10,150}~~ \$14,210 to the House of Representatives to pay for the compensation and
73 expenses

of representatives on the task force.
