Senator Carlene M. Walker proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Line 19:
 - urges that the legislation include increased <u>and effective</u> verification requirements by companies, <u>accompanied by the tools and resources necessary to adequately verify whether or not a Social Security number is fraudulent.</u>
- 2. Page 2, Lines 32 through 33:
 - WHEREAS, contributing to the problems are companies { who } that do not have the tools or resources necessary to adequately verify whether or not a Social Security number is fraudulent and companies that are notified of fraudulent
 - 33 Social Security numbers of employees but take no corrective action; and
- 3. Page 2, Lines 40 through 43:
 - 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature and Governor urge that the
 - legislation include increased <u>and effective</u> verification requirements by companies <u>, accompanied by the tools and resources necessary to adequately verify whether or not a Social Security number is fraudulent, and increased penalties</u>
 - 42 for individuals who intentionally use fraudulent Social Security numbers to obtain
 - employment, avoid child support obligations, or for other personal gain.
