LONG TITLE

General Description:

This joint resolution of the Legislature supports jail expansion in Garfield County through a contract with the Utah Department of Corrections.

Highlighted Provisions:

This resolution:

▶ supports Garfield County's expansion of its correctional facilities by means of a contract between the county and the Utah Department of Corrections.

Special Clauses:

None

Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

WHEREAS, counties contract with the Department of Corrections to provide prison bed space for state prisoners;

WHEREAS, this contracting arrangement has proved beneficial to both the state and the counties and saved taxpayers from the burden of building new state correctional facilities, while at the same time assisting counties to meet their own correctional space needs;

~~§→ [WHEREAS, in accordance with Utah Code Annotated, Subsection 64-13c-401(1), "the department [of Corrections] may enter into a contract with a county government to house inmates only if the Legislature has previously passed a joint resolution" containing the~~
