WHEREAS, Ronald Wilson Reagan, a man of humble background, worked throughout
his life serving freedom and advancing the public good;
WHEREAS, Ronald Reagan worked as an entertainer, union leader, corporate
spokesman, Governor of California, and President of the United States;
WHEREAS, Ronald Reagan served with honor and distinction for two terms as the
40th president of the United States of America;
WHEREAS, in 1981, when Ronald Reagan was inaugurated President, he inherited a
disillusioned nation shackled by rampant inflation and high unemployment;

32	nation's children helped lower crime and drug use in our neighborhoods;
