ENACTS UNCODIFIED MATERIAL

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. **Appropriation to the Department of Natural Resources to fund urban trails.**

(1) As an ongoing appropriation subject to future budget constraints, there is appropriated from the General Fund for fiscal year 2008-09, \$500,000 to the Department of
