8 **LONG TITLE**

9 **General Description:**

10 This bill appropriates \$19.7 million dollars for design and construction of a Veterans'
11 Nursing Home in Ogden.

12 **Highlighted Provisions:**

13 This bill:

- 14 ▶ appropriates \$19.7 million dollars for design and construction of a Veterans'
15 Nursing Home in Ogden;
- 16 ▶ expresses legislative intent to not fund design or construction of any future veterans'
17 nursing homes until the state is reimbursed by the federal government for its share
18 of the cost of the Ogden Veterans' Nursing Home; and
- 19 ▶ repeals an authorization to issue a general obligation bond to partially fund
20 construction of a Veterans' Nursing Home in Ogden.

21 **Monies Appropriated in this Bill:**

22 This bill appropriates:

- 23 ▶ for fiscal year 2008-09 only, \$19.7 million to the Division of Facilities Construction
24 and Management for the design and construction of a Veterans' Nursing Home in
25 Ogden, Utah.

47 (1) For fiscal year 2008-09 only, there is appropriated \$19,700,000 from the General
48 Fund to the Division of Facilities Construction and Management to design and construct a
49 Veteran's Nursing Home in Ogden, Utah.

50 (2) It is the intent of the Legislature that the Legislature will not appropriate or provide
51 any additional monies for the design or construction of any additional Veteran's Nursing
52 Homes in Utah until the state has received full payment from the federal government for the
53 federal government's share of the costs of design and construction of the Ogden Veteran's
54 Nursing Home.
