This concurrent resolution of the Legislature and the Governor expresses support for a 1984 water rights agreement and for the Narrows Water Project in Central Utah.

35 *Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah, the Governor concurring therein:*

36 WHEREAS, water is fundamental to the economic base of Central Utah communities,
37 and reliable water storage is necessary for both agricultural and municipal development;

38 WHEREAS, legal agreements between Sanpete County, Carbon County, the state of
39 Utah, and various federal entities have recognized Carbon and Sanpete County's water rights
40 from Gooseberry Creek; and

41 WHEREAS, a June 8, 1984 agreement between the Sanpete County Water
42 Conservancy District, the Carbon Water Conservancy District, and the Price River Water Users
43 Association defined the water rights of all parties and supported the Narrows Water Project on
44 Gooseberry Creek:

45 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah, the
46 Governor concurring therein, express support for the June 8, 1984 agreement between the
47 Sanpete County Water Conservancy District, the Carbon Water Conservancy District, and the
48 Price River Water Users Association which defines the water rights of all parties and supports
49 the Narrows Water Project on Gooseberry Creek.

50 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be sent to the Bureau of
51 Reclamation and to Utah's congressional delegation.
