25	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
26	Section 1. Section <b>65A-8-101</b> is amended to read:
27	65A-8-101. Division responsibilities for fire control and the preservation of forest,
28	watershed, and other lands Reciprocal agreements for fire protection.
29	(1) The division shall determine and execute the best [methods] method for protecting

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30	private and public property by:
31	(a) except as provided by Subsection (1)(e), preventing the origin and spread of fire on
32	nonfederal forest, range, [and] or watershed [lands] land in an unincorporated [areas] area of
33	the state;
34	(b) protecting <u>a</u> nonfederal forest [and] <u>or</u> watershed [areas on] <u>area using</u> conservation
35	principles; [and]
36	(c) encouraging <u>a</u> private [ <del>landowners in preserving, protecting, and managing</del> ]
37	<u>landowner to preserve, protect, and manage</u> forest [and] or other [lands] <u>land</u> throughout the
38	state[ <del>-</del> ];
39	[(2) The division shall take] (d) taking action [it] the division considers [necessary]
40	appropriate to control wildland [fires] fire and protect life and property on the nonfederal forest
41	range, [and] or watershed [lands] land within an unincorporated [areas] area of the state[:]; and
42	(e) implementing a limited fire suppression strategy, including allowing a fire to burn
43	with limited or modified suppression, if the division determines that the strategy is appropriate
44	for a specific area or circumstance.
45	$\left[\frac{3}{2}\right]$ (2) The division may:
46	(a) enter into [agreements] an agreement with a public or private [agencies, or
47	individuals] agency or individual:
48	(i) for the [express] purpose of protecting, managing, or rehabilitating [those lands.]
49	land owned or managed by the agency or individual; and
50	(ii) establishing a predetermined fire suppression plan, including a limited fire
51	suppression strategy, for a specific fire management area; and
52	[(4) The division may] (b) enter into a reciprocal agreement with [any] a fire protection
53	organization, including <u>a</u> federal [agencies] <u>agency</u> , to provide fire protection for land and
54	[improvements] an improvement for which the organization normally provides fire protection.
