General Description:

This bill modifies the Election Code by amending pollbook provisions.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

▶ repeals the requirement that the local clerk or recorder transmit the pollbook (the record of names of voters) to the county clerk after the canvass of a November municipal election, local district election, bond election, or special election.

20A-4-305, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2007, Chapter 329

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **20A-4-305** is amended to read:

20A-4-305. Delivery of checked official register to county clerk after canvass.

29 election, bond election, or special election, the clerk or recorder shall transmit the checked
