28 As used in this [act] chapter: 29 (1) "Prevail" means to obtain favorable final judgment, the right to all appeals having 30 been exhausted, on the merits, on substantially all counts or charges in the action and with 31 respect to the most significant issue or set of issues presented, but does not include the 32 settlement of any action, either by stipulation, consent decree or otherwise, whether or not 33 settlement occurs before or after any hearing or trial. 34 (2) "Reasonable litigation expenses" means court costs, administrative hearing costs, 35 [attorney's] attorney fees, and witness fees of all necessary witnesses, not in excess of [\$10,000] \$35,000, which a court finds were reasonably incurred in opposing action covered 36 37 under this [act] chapter. 38 (3) "Small business" means a commercial or business entity, including a sole 39 proprietorship, which does not have more than 250 employees, but does not include an entity 40 which is a subsidiary or affiliate of another entity which is not a small business. (4) "State" means any department, board, institution, hospital, college, or university of 41 42 the state of Utah or any political subdivision thereof, except with respect to antitrust actions 43 brought under Title 76, Chapter 10, Part 9.
