LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies Title 64, Chapter 13, Department of Corrections-State Prison, regarding hearings.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

▶ repeals the requirement that the Department of Corrections maintain an administrative hearing office to conduct hearings related to:

- offenders in the custody of the department; and
- administrative matters and issues involving staff; and

▶ repeals the powers and duties of the hearing officer.
