26	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
27	Section 1. Section 20A-1-503 is amended to read:
28	20A-1-503. Midterm vacancies in the Legislature.
29	(1) As used in this section, "party liaison" means the political party officer designated
30	to serve as a liaison with the lieutenant governor on all matters relating to the political party's
31	relationship with the state as required by Section 20A-8-401.
32	(2) When a vacancy occurs for any reason in the office of representative in the
33	Legislature, the governor shall fill the vacancy by immediately appointing the person whose
34	name was submitted by the party liaison of the same political party as the prior representative.
35	(3) (a) (i) [When] Except as provided in Subsection (3)(b), when a vacancy occurs for
36	any reason in the office of senator in the Legislature, [it] the vacancy shall be filled for the
37	unexpired term at the next regular general election.
38	[(b)] (ii) The governor shall fill the vacancy until the next regular general election by
39	immediately appointing the person whose name was submitted by the party liaison of the same
40	political party as the prior senator.
41	(b) Beginning on January 1, 2008, when a vacancy exists in the office of senator in the
42	Legislature due to the death of a state senator, the governor shall fill the vacancy for the
43	unexpired term by immediately appointing the person whose name was submitted by the party
44	liaison of the same political party as the deceased senator.
45	Section 2. Effective date.
46	If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, this bill takes effect
47	upon approval by the governor, or the day following the constitutional time limit of Utah
48	Constitution Article VII, Section 8, without the governor's signature, or in the case of a veto,
49	the date of veto override.
