The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee recommends **H.B. 40, SAFE DRINKING WATER REVISIONS**, by Representative S. Andersen, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 40, SAFE DRINKING WATER REVISIONS** with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 13 through 15:*

- 13       ▶ requires a first or second class county to adopt an ordinance to protect a  
source of public drinking water;
- 14       ▶ authorizes a municipality located in a first or second class county to adopt  
an ordinance to protect a source of public
- 15   drinking water;

2. *Page 3, Line 81:*

81       (1) (a) Before May 3, 2010, a first or second class county shall:

3. *Page 4, Lines 93 through 94:*

93       (b) A municipality in a first or second class county may adopt an ordinance that  
a first or second class county is required to adopt by this

94   section by following the procedures and requirements of this section.

4. *Page 4, Line 110:*

110       (c) authorize a retail water supplier or wholesale water supplier to seek  
enforcement of the ordinance in a district court located
