Mr. Speaker:

The Transportation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 122**, DRIVER LICENSE - APPLICATION OF MINOR AMENDMENTS, by Representative D. Litvack, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 21 through 22:*

21 ▶ limits the liability of a foster parent who signs an application for a foster child's
22 driver license { ~~or furnishes a motor vehicle to a foster child~~ } ;

2. *Page 2, Line 44:*

3. *Page 9, Lines 252 through 267:*
