NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

February 27, 2008

Mr. Speaker:

With committee review, the Transportation Committee recommends **1st Sub. H.B. 228**, AMENDMENTS TO MOTOR VEHICLE PROVISIONS, by Representative C. Herrod, be replaced with **2nd Sub. H.B. 228**, AMENDMENTS TO MOTOR VEHICLE PROVISIONS, with the following amendments, and has returned it to the Rules Committee without recommendation:

- 0. Page 1, Lines 17 through 20:
 - 17 a person {
 - who has not been granted the privilege to operate a motor vehicle on a highway;
 - 19 or
 - whose privilege to operate a motor vehicle on a highway has been denied.
- 0. *Page 3, Lines 68 through 75:*
 - (v) authorizing a peace officer to seize and take possession of a vehicle, vessel, or
 - outboard motor in accordance with the requirements of Section 41-1a-1101 if the vehicle,
 - vessel, or outboard motor is being operated on a highway within the highway authority's
 - 71 jurisdiction by a person {
 - 72 (i) who has not been granted the privilege to operate a vehicle on a highway in
 - 73 accordance with Section 53-3-202; or
 - 74 <u>(ii)</u>} whose privilege to operate a vehicle on a highway has been denied, suspended,
 - 75 revoked, or disqualified.
