NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

February 26, 2008

Mr. Speaker:

With committee review, the Government Operations Committee has returned **H.B. 338**, NEUTRALITY REQUIRED OF POLL WORKERS, by Representative R. Chavez-Houck, to the Rules Committee without recommendation with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 12 through 14:
 - prohibits a poll worker from wearing or displaying a logo, insignia, letters, or words
 - that disclose the poll worker's support of, opposition to, or affiliation with a
 - candidate, political party, <u>or</u> political issue { , corporation, or advocacy organization } ;
- 2. *Page 2, Lines 31 through 34:*
 - 31 (b) (i) A poll worker, while present at the polling place, may not wear or display, in a
 - 32 <u>manner that is visible to voters, a logo, insignia, letters, or words that disclose the poll</u> <u>worker's</u>
 - support of, opposition to, or affiliation with a candidate, political party, or political issue {:
 - 34 <u>corporation, or advocacy organization</u>} <u>.</u>
