NOTICE OF BILL RETURNED TO RULES COMMITTEE

February 26, 2008

Mr. Speaker:

With committee review, the Government Operations Committee has returned **H.B. 338**, NEUTRALITY REQUIRED OF POLL WORKERS, by Representative R. Chavez-Houck, to the Rules Committee without recommendation with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 12 through 14:*

- 12 ▶ prohibits a poll worker from wearing or displaying a logo, insignia, letters, or
words
13 that disclose the poll worker's support of, opposition to, or affiliation with a
14 candidate, political party, or political issue {~~, corporation, or advocacy~~
~~organization~~} ;

2. *Page 2, Lines 31 through 34:*

- 31 (b) (i) A poll worker, while present at the polling place, may not wear or display, in a
32 manner that is visible to voters, a logo, insignia, letters, or words that disclose the poll
worker's
33 support of, opposition to, or affiliation with a candidate, political party, or political
issue {~~—~~
34 ~~corporation, or advocacy organization~~} .
