2. Page 4, Lines 111 through 115:

- 112 76-5-311. Affirmative defense.
- 113 <u>Human trafficking is an affirmative defense to prosecution of a person for a criminal</u>
- 114 <u>violation directly related to the defendant's status as a victim of a crime that is a violation of</u>
- 115 this section.
