Mr. President:

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 14, SMOKING BAN IN MOTOR VEHICLE**, by Senator S. McCoy, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 21 through 23:*

- 21 the person has enrolled in a smoking cessation program; ~~{and}~~  
22     ▶ provides that enforcement of the smoking prohibition shall be only as a  
    secondary  
23 action : and  
    ▶ provides that a violation of the smoking prohibition may not be used as a basis  
    for or evidence of child abuse or neglect .

2. *Page 2, Line 49:*

- 49 person in the vehicle of Title 41, Motor Vehicles, other than this section, or for another  
offense.  
(6) A violation of this section may not be used as a basis for or evidence of child  
abuse or neglect as defined in Section 62A-4a-402.
