The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on S.B. 152, PRESUMPTIVE PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE, by Senator G. Bell, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 48 through 53
- 48 (4) Any insurer and its insured paying a claim arising out of the wrongful death of a person, including
- 49 <u>a minor, including but not limited to claims for uninsured or underinsured motorist coverage as</u>
- 50 provided in Section 31A-22-305, to a presumptive personal representative upon presentation of
- 51 <u>an affidavit as described in Subsection (2)</u> {is} <u>are</u> <u>discharged and released to the same extent as if</u>
- 52 the insurer and its insured dealt with a personal representative of the decedent. The insurer and its insured is not required to
- 53 <u>inquire into the truth of any statement in the affidavit.</u>
