The Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 177**, LOCAL GOVERNMENT DISPOSAL OF REAL PROPERTY ACQUIRED BY EXACTION, by Senator W. Niederhauser, with the following amendments:

1. Page 1, Lines 14 through 17

Senate Committee Amendments
