1. S.B. 157 Rights of Citizens to Carry Firearms in Declared Emergency (*M. Madsen*)

Sen. Madsen explained that a substitute bill was being drafted. The bill was held in committee.

2. S.B. 139 Utah Antitrust Act Amendments (*L. Hillyard*)

Sen. Hillyard presented the bill and introduced Ron Oakey, Assistant Utah Attorney General, who explained the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Hillyard moved to send S.B. 139 out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. McCoy absent for the vote.

MOTION: Sen. Hillyard moved to place S.B. 139 on the consent calendar.

3. **H.B. 30 Vehicle concealing Illegal Items** (*P. Ray*)

Gerald Jensen, Assistant Attorney General, Utah Attorney General, spoke in favor of the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Greiner moved to send H.B. 30 out of the committee with a favorable recommendation.

4. **H.B. 18 S01 Material Harmful to Minors Amendments** (*P. Ray*)

Rep. Ray presented and explained the bill.
