

**H.B. 171**  
**DRIVING PRIVILEGE CARD AMENDMENTS**

Senator **Mark B. Madsen** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Line 24:*

24 Identification Database Program;

▶ prohibits a financial institution from accepting a driving privilege card from a person as proof of identification for the purpose of establishing personal identification when engaging in certain financial transactions;

2. *Page 2, Lines 50 through 52:*

50 76-10-526, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2004, Chapter 360

ENACTS:

7-1-811, Utah Code Annotated 1953

52 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section 7-1-811 is enacted to read:

7-1-811. Financial institution acceptance of driving privilege card prohibited.

A financial institution may not accept a driving privilege card issued in accordance with Section 53-3-207 from a person as proof of identification for the purpose of establishing personal identification when:

(1) engaging in a transaction involving an account with a financial institution; or

(2) engaging in the business of a check casher as defined in Section 7-23-102.

Renumber remaining sections accordingly.
