24	Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
25	Section 1. JR3-2-302 is amended to read:
26	JR3-2-302. Appropriation Subcommittees Created Membership Quorum
27	and Voting Requirements.
28	(1) The members of the Joint Appropriations Committee shall be divided into the
29	following subcommittees:

H.J.R. 18

30	(a) Capital Facilities and Government Operations;
31	(b) Commerce and Workforce Services;
32	(c) Economic Development and Revenue;
33	(d) Executive Offices and Criminal Justice;
34	(e) Health and Human Services;
35	(f) Higher Education;
36	(g) Natural Resources;
37	(h) Public Education;
38	(i) Retirement and Independent Entities; and
39	(j) Transportation, Environmental Quality, [and] National Guard, and Veterans'
40	Affairs.
41	(2) Subject to Subsection (3), the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House
42	shall appoint their respective members to each subcommittee.
43	(3) The Retirement and Independent Entities Subcommittee shall have the same
44	members as the Retirement and Independent Entities Committee created in Section
45	63E-1-201.
46	(4) (a) A majority of any appropriations subcommittee is a quorum for the transaction
47	of business.
48	(b) In determining a subcommittee quorum, a majority is at least 50% in one house
49	and more than 50% in the other.
50	(5) (a) In all decisions of the subcommittees, a majority vote prevails.
51	(b) A majority vote is at least 50% of the members of one house and more than 50% in
52	the other house in attendance.
