LONG TITLE**General Description:**

This bill repeals a sunset provision relating to townships.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ repeals a provision that repeals in 2010 a provision prohibiting the legislative body of a municipality in a county of the first class from approving an annexation petition involving an area located in a township unless the annexation petition includes the entire area of the township or the annexation has been approved by township voters or property owners.
