LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill modifies provisions relating to the board of trustees of mosquito abatement districts.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ provides that up to two members of a mosquito abatement district board of trustees need not be residents of the mosquito abatement district, if the members reside within the boundary of their respective appointing municipality.

17B-2a-704, as enacted by Laws of Utah 2007, Chapter 329

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:



26 Section 1. Section **17B-2a-704** is amended to read:

27 **17B-2a-704. Mosquito abatement district board of trustees.**

28 (1) (a) (i) Notwithstanding Subsection 17B-1-302(2) and subject to Subsection (1)(b),
29 the legislative body of each municipality that is entirely or partly included within a mosquito
30 abatement district shall appoint one member to the board of trustees.

31 (ii) (A) Notwithstanding Subsection 17B-1-302(1)(a)(ii), a member of the board of
32 trustees appointed under Subsection (1)(a)(i) need not be a resident within the boundary of the
33 mosquito abatement district if the member resides within the boundary of the municipality
34 whose legislative body appoints the member, subject to Subsection (1)(a)(ii)(B).

35 (B) A mosquito abatement district board of trustees may not have more than two
36 members serving on the board at any one time who are residents outside the boundary of the
37 district.

38 (b) If 75% or more of the area of a mosquito abatement district is within the boundaries
39 of a single municipality:

40 (i) the board of trustees shall consist of five members; and

41 (ii) the legislative body of that municipality shall appoint all five members of the
42 board.

43 (2) The legislative body of each county in which a mosquito abatement district is
44 located shall appoint one member to the district's board of trustees if:

45 (a) some or all of the county's unincorporated area is included within the boundaries of
46 the mosquito abatement district; or

47 (b) (i) the number of municipalities that are entirely or partly included within the
48 district is an even number less than nine; and

49 (ii) Subsection (1)(b) does not apply.

50 (3) If the number of board members appointed by application of Subsections (1) and
51 (2)(a) is an even number less than nine, the legislative body of the county in which the district
52 is located shall appoint an additional member.

53 (4) Each board of trustees member shall be appointed as provided in Section
54 17B-1-304.

55 (5) Each vacancy on a mosquito abatement district board of trustees shall be filled by
56 the applicable appointing authority as provided in Section 17B-1-304.
