LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill requires the board of education of a school district to post a collective bargaining agreement entered into by the board on the school district's website.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

► requires the board of education of a school district to post a collective bargaining agreement entered into by the board on the school district's website within ten days of ratification of the agreement.

53A-3-428, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53A-3-428** is enacted to read:

53A-3-428. Collective bargaining agreement to be posted on school district



28 **website.**

29 (1) As used in this section, "collective bargaining agreement" includes:

30 (a) a master agreement; and

31 (b) an amendment, addendum, memorandum, or other document modifying the master

32 agreement.

33 (2) The board of education of a school district:

34 (a) shall post on the school district's website a collective bargaining agreement entered

35 into by the board of education within ten days of the ratification of the agreement; and

36 (b) may remove from the school district's website a collective bargaining agreement

37 that is no longer in effect.
