Mr. President:

The Government Operations and Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 156**, GIFTS AND MEAL PROVISIONS FOR PUBLIC OFFICIALS, by Senator G. Bell, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 7, Lines 201 through 203:
 - 201 (C) an expenditure made for food or beverage { including the public official's name }, if
 - the aggregate daily expenditures benefitting the public official are greater than [\$50; and] \$25
 - 203 <u>unless the food or beverage is provided in connection with an event to which:</u>
- 2. Page 9, Lines 273 through 274:
 - 273 (b) Notwithstanding Subsection (1)(a), "gift" includes :
 - (i) admission to a sporting,
 - 274 recreational, or artistic event whether as a spectator or a participant ; and (ii) cash .
