Mr. President:

The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee recommends S.B. 228, PROHIBITION ON INTERNET OR MAIL-ORDER SALES OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS, by Senator M. Dayton, be replaced and favorably recommends 1st Sub. S.B. 228, PROHIBITION ON INTERNET OR MAIL-ORDER SALES OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 45 through 50:
 - 45 (2) A person, distributor, manufacturer, or retailer shall not:
 - 46 (a) cause tobacco products or cigarettes as defined in Section 59-22-202 to be ordered or purchased by anyone other than a licensed
 - 47 person; or
 - 48 (b) knowingly provide substantial assistance to a person who violates this section.
 - 49 (3) (a) Each order or purchase of a tobacco product

 Section 59-22-202 in violation of Subsection (2) shall
 - 50 constitute a separate violation under this section.
