Mr. President:

The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee recommends **S.B. 228**, PROHIBITION ON INTERNET OR MAIL-ORDER SALES OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS, by Senator M. Dayton, be replaced and favorably recommends **1st Sub. S.B. 228**, PROHIBITION ON INTERNET OR MAIL-ORDER SALES OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 45 through 50:*

- 45           (2) A person, distributor, manufacturer, or retailer shall not:  
46           (a) cause tobacco products **or cigarettes as defined in Section 59-22-202** to be  
              ordered or purchased by anyone other than a licensed  
47 person; or  
48           (b) knowingly provide substantial assistance to a person who violates this section.  
49           (3) (a) Each order or purchase of a tobacco product **or cigarettes as defined in**  
              **Section 59-22-202** in violation of Subsection (2) shall  
50 constitute a separate violation under this section.
