S.J.R. 9 Resolution Honoring the Utah Law Enforcement Memorial Foundation

1. *Page 2, Lines 43 through 44:*

43 individual who is entitled to custody of the child, or otherwise intentionally {~~or~~
knowingly}

44 interferes with the custody to which that individual is entitled, during a period of time
