 - requires a first { or second } class county and a state or municipal agency located in a
 - 16 first { or second } class county to recycle certain materials.
- 2. Page 2, Line 34:
 - 34 (B) located in a first { or second } class county.

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- 3. Page 3, Lines 61 through 62:
 - 61 (a) (i) "County facility" means a building, structure, or other improvement that is
 - 62 constructed on property owned by a first { or second } class county.
- 4. Page 4, Line 107:
 - 107 (B) located in a first { or second } class county.

The motion failed with Rep. Black, Rep. Chavez-Houck, Rep. Draxler, Rep. Dunnigan, Rep. Edwards, Rep. Fisher, Rep. Greenwood, and Rep. Poulson voting in opposition.
