2. *Page 2, Line 34:*

- 34       (B) located in a first { ~~or second~~ } class county.

3. *Page 3, Lines 61 through 62:*

61 (a) (i) "County facility" means a building, structure, or other improvement that is  
62 constructed on property owned by a first { ~~or second~~ } class county.

4. *Page 4, Line 107:*

107 (B) located in a first { ~~or second~~ } class county.

The motion failed with Rep. Black, Rep. Chavez-Houck, Rep. Draxler, Rep. Dunnigan, Rep. Edwards, Rep. Fisher, Rep. Greenwood, and Rep. Poulson voting in opposition.
