  - 620 <u>served by the college campus without a cooperative agreement between an affected institution</u> <u>, except as</u> provided in Subsection (6) ;
- 4. Page 21, Line 637:
  - 637 Technology Campus."

<u>(6)(a) A college campus may offer career and technical education or basic instruction outside the</u> <u>geographic area served by the college campus without a cooperative agreement, as required in Subsection</u> <u>(3)(c), if:</u>

(i) the career and technical education or basic instruction is specifically requested by:

(A) an employer; or

(B) a craft, trade, or apprenticeship program;

(ii) the college campus notifies the affected institution about the request; and

(iii) the affected institution is given an opportunity to make a proposal, prior to any contract being

finalized or training being initiated by the college campus, to the employer, craft, trade, or apprenticeship

program about offering the requested career and technical education or basic instruction, provided that the proposal shall be presented no later than one business week from the delivery of the notice described under Subsection (6)(b).

(b) The requirements under Subsection (6)(a)(iii) do not apply if there is a prior training relationship.
