It is the intent of the Legislature that, in preparing the Utah Code database for publication, the Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel shall change the effective date of the amendments made to Sections 63G-11-103 and 63G-11-104 in S.B. 39, Immigration Amendments, from July 1, 2009, to July 1, 2010, if both this bill and S.B. 39 pass during the 2009 General Session. =
