# H.B. 261 AVIATION AMENDMENTS

Representative Wayne A. Harper proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 1, Lines 13 through 16:

13 reduces the aviation fuel tax rate that a federally certificated air carrier pays on

14 aviation fuel purchased at an international airport located within a county of the first

15 class that has a United States customs office on its premises from \$.04 to  $\{-\frac{1}{2,026}\}$  on

16 each gallon of aviation fuel;
