ILLEGAL USE OF MOTOR VEHICLES

Representative **Michael E. Noel** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 17 through 19:*

17 ▶ provides that a person may not operate or give another person permission to operate
18 a motor vehicle cross-country on any public land that is closed to motor vehicle
19 cross-country travel with exception ;

2. *Page 2, Lines 26 through 29:*

26 • the person has previously been convicted of the restrictions on use of a motor
27 vehicle cross-country on public land or a motor vehicle on private land
28 or knowingly, intentionally, or recklessly causes certain damage or
29 harasses wildlife or livestock;

3. *Page 3, Lines 58 through 59:*

58 (3) (a) "All-terrain type II vehicle" means any other motor vehicle, not defined in
59 Subsection (2), ~~{(9)}~~ (10) , or ~~{(20)}~~ (21) , designed for or capable of travel over unimproved
 terrain.

4. *Page 5, Lines 122 through 124:*

122 (1) ~~{A}~~ (a) Except as provided in Subsection (1)(b), a person may not operate and an owner
 of a motor vehicle may not give another
123 person permission to operate a motor vehicle cross-country on any public land that is closed to
124 motor vehicle cross-country travel.

(b) A person operating a snowmobile on sufficient snow cover cross-country on public land is not subject to the restriction in Subsection (1)(a).
