Representative **Ron Bigelow** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 2, Line 58 through Page 3, Line 75:

58 (4) To the extent that funds will be available for appropriation in a given fiscal year,  
59 those funds shall be appropriated from the account in the following order:

73 Sciences Center to benefit the health and well-being of Utah citizens through in-state research,  
74 treatment, and educational activities;

(d) \$500,000 to the Department of Health for the Gold Medal Schools Program;  
(e) as funds are available, to the Department of Health for alcohol, tobacco and other drug  
prevention, reduction, cessation and control programs with a preference in funding given to tobacco-  
related programs; and

75 ~~[(f)]~~ (e) any remaining funds as directed by the Legislature through appropriation.

2. Page 3, Lines 78 through 82:

78 (b) The amount appropriated from the Tobacco Settlement Restricted Account to the  
79 Department of Health for alcohol, tobacco, and other drug programs described in Subsection  
80 (4) ~~{(b)}~~ (e), including the funding preference for tobacco-related programs, shall be increased by up  
81 to \$2,000,000 in a given fiscal year to the extent that funds in dispute for attorney fees are  
82 available to the state for appropriation from the account.
