Representative **Ron Bigelow** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Line 58 through Page 3, Line 75:
  - 58 (4) To the extent that funds will be available for appropriation in a given fiscal year,

  - (e) as funds are available, to the Department of Health for alcohol, tobacco and other drug prevention, reduction, cessation and control programs with a preference in funding given to tobacco-related programs; and
- 75 [(f)] (e) any remaining funds as directed by the Legislature through appropriation.
- 2. *Page 3, Lines 78 through 82:* 
  - 78 (b) The amount appropriated from the Tobacco Settlement Restricted Account to the
  - 79 Department of Health for alcohol, tobacco, and other drug programs described in Subsection
  - 80 (4) {-(b)} (e) , including the funding preference for tobacco-related programs, shall be increased by up
  - 81 to \$2,000,000 in a given fiscal year to the extent that funds in dispute for attorney fees are
  - 82 available to the state for appropriation from the account.
